

Applauding the 2018 American Nurses Foundation Scholars

The American Nurses Foundation is grateful for the generosity of supporters over the last 63 years who have made it possible to award more than \$5 million to more than 1,100 beginning and experienced nurse researchers.

The Foundation completed its 2018 annual research grant process this fall. The nursing research grant program review committee was led by Chair Gordon L. Gillespie, PhD, DNP, RN, CEN, CNE, CPEN, PHCNS-BC, FAEN, FAAN, associate professor, deputy director of occupational health nursing program, interim associate dean for research and translation, at the University of Cincinnati and Vice-Chair Joan Insalaco Warren, PhD, RN-BC, NEA-BC, FAAN, Associate Professor, University of Maryland; Project Director, MD Nurse Residency Collaborative.

Twenty-six grants were awarded to nurse researchers across the country, and totaled over \$260,000, through funding by external funding associations and corporations, and by endowments funds targeted to support nurse-led research.

The research projects focus on a variety of nursing science topics, from a cardiovascular risk assessment for late adolescents, to a study on the health effects of walking with a companion, to workforce and leadership development of minority nurses in public health environments and to a retrospective cohort study on the transitions in care for older nursing home residents with dementia.
