

Elevating Nurses and Advancing the Nursing Profession

Nurses are on the frontlines of healthcare every day, delivering exceptional care while also serving as the heart of the nation's health system. They provide essential services across a broad spectrum of settings, from hospitals to community clinics. Nurses deliver direct patient care, manage complex cases, and coordinate treatment plans, ensuring continuity and quality of care. Their role extends beyond the bedside to include patient education and advocacy. Nurses make significant contributions to healthcare innovation by engaging in research and developing new technologies. Amidst a growing demand for healthcare services and a shortage of healthcare professionals, nurses are vital in addressing gaps and improving health outcomes.

With over 5 million registered nurses across the nation, the ANA Enterprise—encompassing the American Nurses Association, the American Nurses Foundation, and the American Nurses Credentialing Center—continues to be a steadfast supporter of the nursing community.

In 2023, we expanded and enhanced investments in nurses' mental health and well-being, bringing our total number of nurses trained as Stress First Aid Champions through the Nurse Well-Being: Building Peer and Leadership Support program to over 1,000 nationwide. We hosted events focused on critical issues such as burnout, aimed at creating healthier workplaces.



We championed and recognized exceptional nurse leaders

having an impact on the profession through the Jeannine Rivet National Leadership Award.

We promoted professional growth and fostered connections for underrepresented leaders by establishing the Scholarship for Change program with support from Stryker to cover the cost of attending the Magnet/Pathway Conference for nurses of color.

We fueled nurse-led innovation and significantly impacted nursing education, technology, and practice by granting \$15 million from 2022-2025 to 10 pilot programs spanning 54 sites across 31 states through the Reimagining Nursing Initiative.

We provided critically needed funding for nursing science

through the Nursing Research Grants program for nurse researchers studying work environment and strategically targeted diseases.
